University Libraries at the University of Louisville (“UL”) and *you as Author* wish to enter into a nonexclusive license in order to preserve and make widely available your thesis or dissertation Work (“the Work”) identified and described more fully herein by title as _____

This nonexclusive arrangement allows UofL to make the Work accessible through any existing and later developed technologies and formats and consistent with the goals of scholarship and library practices but does not limit your opportunities as Author and copyright holder to make other uses of the Work.

To that end:

1. You as Author retain all rights in the Work subject to the nonexclusive grants and agreements described more fully below and hold sole responsibility for complying with copyright and other legal requirements in the U.S. and elsewhere as they may govern the ownership and enforcement rights of Author.
